From 1982 to 1994 Mr. Holton was employed by Hammil McKinney Architects, in Lexington, Kentucky. As a staff architect, he was involved in the practice of architecture with an emphasis on design development, detailing, specification writing and quality control. His primary responsibility was design and construction documents for proto-type restaurant chains and multiple adaptive schemes for site adaptation of the proto-type.

From 1984 to 1989 Mr. Holton was staff Architect for the Denham-Blythe Company, a design-build construction firm located in Lexington, Kentucky. His projects included design and contract administration of industrial manufacturing plants, hospital additions/renovations, office buildings, banks and several projects for the University of Kentucky.

From 1989 to 1995, Mr. Holton served as a project Architect for SCB Architects in Lexington. Mr. Holton was responsible for major projects from inception through construction. This responsibility included team management, design, construction documents, specifications, bidding and contract administration. Typical projects included the Renovation/Addition of Tates Creek High School, The LEXTRAN Transit Center and the 500 Unit Canal Square Apartments. Mr Holton took leave from his office duties to serve as the Resident Construction Administrator on the 82,000 SF Crabbe Library Expansion at Eastern Kentucky University.

From 1998 to 2008, Mr. Holton was self employed as Buckley Holton Architect, providing full architectural services with emphasis on specifications, quality control, construction consultation and contract administration. During this time Mr. Holton designed a wide variety of projects including medical offices, horse farms, residences, commercial and religious facilities.

Mr. Holton began work with Taylor • Whitney Architects in 2008 as Senior Architect. His work at TWArc continues to focus on documents as well as project management.
